

Who Are We?

- Our Mission: The Community Responders Network is a grassroots coalition committed to confronting and preventing incidents of bias in Central PA.
- We all know that bias and intolerance happens in our communities, but sometimes it
 is difficult to know how best to respond to or prevent it.
- The Community Responders Network was established in 2008 following an incident targeting a local Muslim family. A concerned group of individuals came together to stand with the family, and out of this the Community Responders Network was born.
- Today, our membership represents a diverse group of faith communities, non-profit organizations, educational institutions, government entities and community members working together to further our mission.
- The Community Responders Network is closely connected with individuals and organizations in our community, to apprise us of what is happening and what is needed from CRN.
- We also work closely with agencies like the PA Human Relations Commission, the Southern Poverty Law Center and the Anti-Defamation League to apprise them of bias incidents so that they can track them and take any necessary actions.
- While our initial focus was on dealing with the immediate impact of bias incidents, our work has come to take a dual approach – both responding to incidents that occur, AND taking pro-active steps to prevent these types of incidents.



What Do We Do?

- Our Rapid Response Team develops and implements action plans in response to incidents of bias in Central PA. On-going projects include:
 - Response to Hate Groups: When hate groups like the KKK are active in our area, the CRN makes strong public statements, contacts local leaders and provides resources and guidance for how communities should respond.
 - Response to Hate Crimes: When hate crimes are committed, the CRN
 makes strong public statements, provides resources to affected communities
 and offers support to the victim(s).
 - Response to Bias Incidents: When incidents of bias occur in our area, the CRN makes strong public statements, contacts appropriate authorities and provides resources and support.
- Our Prevention & Education Team develops and implements programs to address the root causes of bias through education. Current projects include:
 - Community Dialogues: Presenting scripted dialogues on race, religion and sexuality to stimulate conversation and break down stereotypes.
 - Conversations with our Neighbors: Creating opportunities for community members to come together and discuss important topics like Islam or race.
 - American Stories: Sharing diverse and compelling stories about what it means to be "American" with students in school settings.
