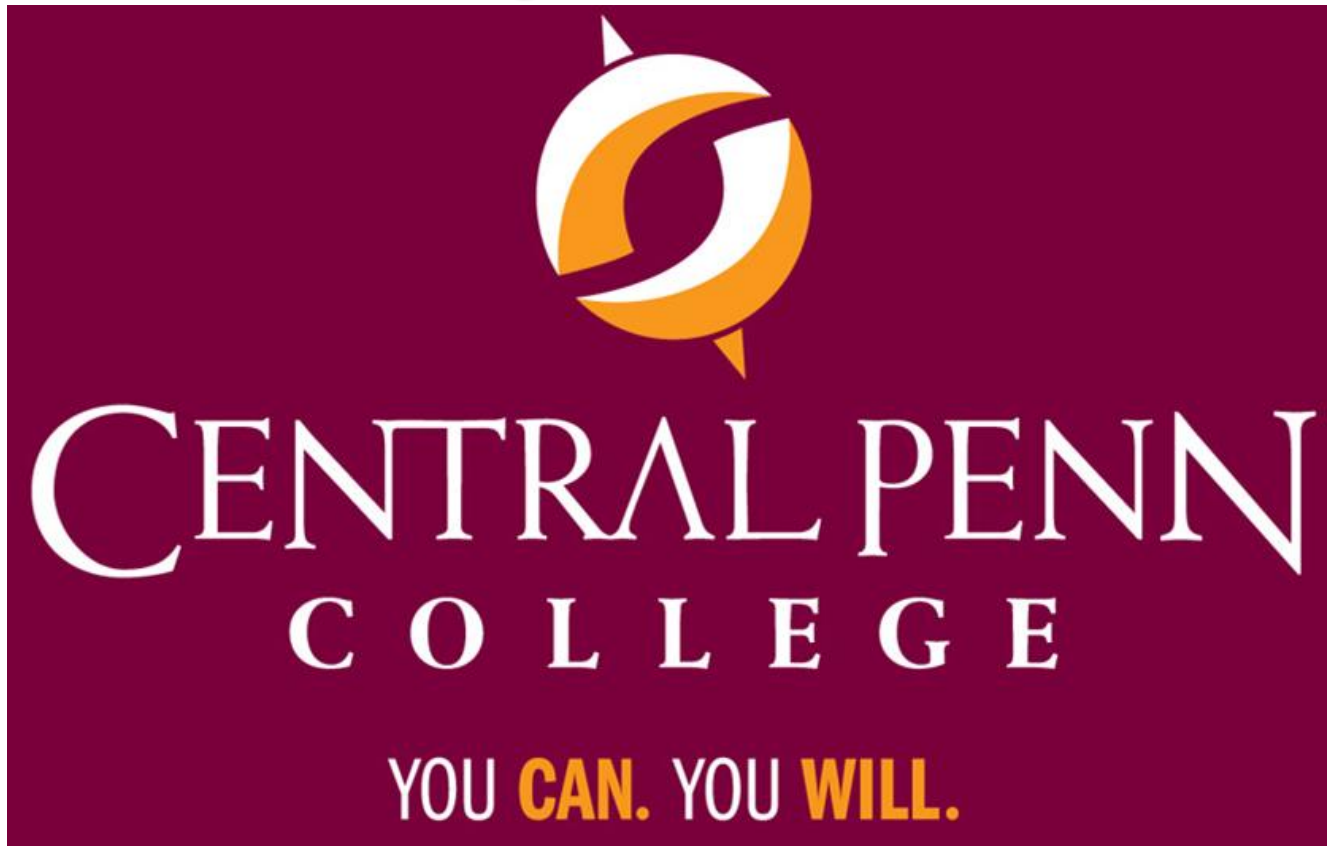

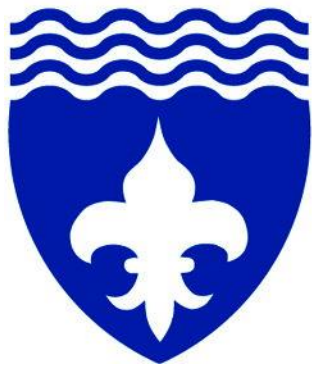

He has championed the importance of diversifying the academy, enhancing graduate education, re-visioning the liberal arts, exploring the role of digital tools for learning and connecting universities to their communities. Lewis is the author and co-editor of seven books, including "Our Compelling Interests: The Value of Diversity for Democracy and a Prosperous Society."
